4. COMPETING CLASSES

Two categories will participate in the 2026 1:5 I.C. Track World Championship:

1. OPEN - no restrictions on motor tuning parts
2. SPORTMAN - with the standard Zenoah motor

The classes will follow the EFRA rules.

5. LOSTALLO AND TOURISM

Lostallo is a small village with almost every convenience. Virtually everything can be found in the valley, from the construction company to the butcher's shop, from the pizzeria to the hotel with restaurant. 6.4 PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION TO REACH THE TRACK

The track is easily accessible by car from both the SOUTH and the NORTH. Simply take the Lostallo motorway exit and follow the signs for "Mini Racing".

Alternatively, you can reach the village of Lostallo by public transport.

From Bellinzona railway station: Bus line 171

- **What to do:** Take bus line 171 from Bellinzona station.
- **Destination:** You will arrive in Lostallo, "north" stop.
- **Duration:** Approximately 24 minutes.
- **Cost:** Approximately CHF 3.00–5.00.

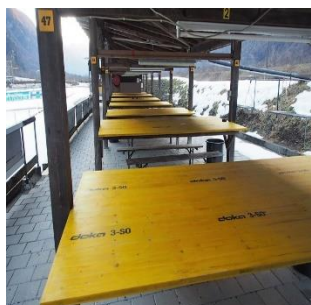

The Lostallo track offers 150 covered seats, large and spacious tables, 230V CH and EU sockets, lighting on all tables, there are 4 points for cleaning the cars.

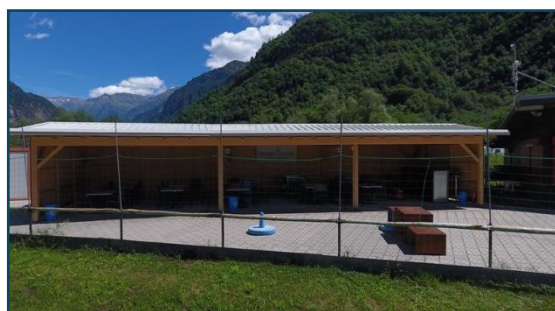

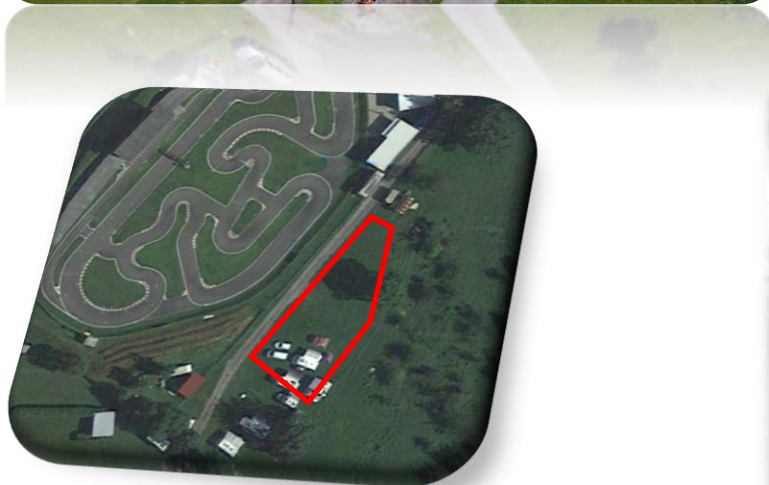
7.4 CAMPING AREA

The Lostallo track has a campsite owned by the club with a surface area of 7'000m².

At the campsite it is possible to connect to 230V electricity, there are showers and toilets available.



In case of need, two other areas close to the track can be used for temporary camping.

8. EVENT ORGANISATION

8.1 TIMING SYSTEM

We have been using **Race Control Management (RCM) Ultimate** timing software from **RC-Timing** on our track for many years with great satisfaction.



The technical side is managed using RC4 decoders and personal transponders from MyLaps.



8.2 LIVE STREAMING AND VIDEO SUPPORT

Live streaming will be handled by PullstartTV (www.pullstart.tv), which will be present from Monday until the end of the event.



The Lostallo racetrack and PullstartTV have been collaborating for many years now, and the entire PullstartTV team has always demonstrated competence and expertise. Therefore, this decision should be seen as a confirmation of esteem and a sign of continuity in a relationship of trust that is now well established. PullstartTV will be supported by a commentator who will describe the race for the people around the track and for those who will be connected via live streaming from home.

In addition, there will also be a video-maker on the track who will be responsible for taking special footage with drones and conducting interviews, pit walks and track walks.

We are confident that with our media team, the World Championships will be excellent publicity for our sport and will provide even more detailed coverage than in the past, showing what goes on behind the scenes at such an event!

9.2 TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Technical Inspection will be held on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday 08.00** until **18.30** in provisional heat order. Drivers or mechanics have to present their cars with bodies, empty tanks, a bottle of fuel and transmitters.

9.3 OPENING CEREMONY

An Opening Ceremony will take place on Tuesday afternoon. The time must be published in the time schedule. Competitors will participate in a welcoming procession. Each national team is asked to wear similar shirts. A flag and sign bearing the name of each country will be provided by the organiser for each team.

Before the conclusion of the opening ceremony, there will be a competition for the most beautiful bodywork, which means that each driver must have the body they intend to present with them throughout the opening ceremony.



9.4 PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY AND BANQUET

On Saturday evening, after the track activities have concluded, a final banquet will be organised, during which the official award ceremony will also take place!

The 1. August is also Swiss National Day, so we will try to involve everyone present in the traditional celebrations associated with our national holiday!
